



Warren and Marcella Stutzman Memorial Scholarship Application

Established 2000

The Warren Stutzman Memorial Scholarship is offered to Tri-Valley High School graduates for college, university and technical school beyond the high school level. High school seniors accepted into a full-time program are eligible to apply. Candidates will be considered primarily based on athletic achievement, with secondary consideration given to scholastic achievement, leadership ability, and community involvement. Available scholarship funds are derived from the annual earnings of the Warren Stutzman Memorial Scholarship Fund established by his brother, Jim Stutzman.

This scholarship shall be paid directly to the college in two equal parts, the first being paid immediately, and the second payment shall not be made until the recipient has completed his/her first semester of schooling. Each recipient must complete a Student Release Form at the completion of his/her first semester. If the student fails to return the form and/or is no longer pursuing his/her education the scholarship shall be forfeited.

Criteria:

- Graduating high school senior of Tri-Valley High School
- Plans to attend a college, university or technical school
- Primarily based upon athletic achievements
- Secondary consideration given to scholastic achievement, leadership ability and community involvement
- Must attain a 2.5 grade point average for the first semester of college

All applications must be returned to the Guidance Office at the address listed below by April 1st.
