

## **Message from our Executive Director**

I am pleased to share the Schuylkill Area Community Foundation 2019 Annual Report with our donors and friends. Even though we are in the midst of a worldwide pandemic, we wish to share with you some highlights of 2019.

We continue to build a better tomorrow, one block at a time. In 2019, SACF technology was updated, which included a new server, new desktop computers, Wi-Fi access, updated email addresses, updates to our eGrant application system, and changes to our paper scholarship applications which include fillable PDFs. We continue to review our processes and procedures to find efficiencies and opportunities to reduce our operational budget, which enables us to provide additional financial support for our Schuylkill County community.

In 2019, SACF provided \$843,153.43 in grants, graduation awards, and scholarships to our Schuylkill County nonprofits and students. The positive impact that our organizations and students are making on our community is widespread and diverse.

Schuylkill County nonprofits continue to implement and present projects and programs to better our community. For example, Schuylkill County's VISION partnered with the North Schuylkill School District to build and plant gardens at the elementary school for fourth grade students to learn the life cycle and benefits of fresh fruits and vegetables. Downtown Shenandoah Inc. presented a Mariachi band during their 21st Annual Heritage Day Festival. Our local public libraries purchased new large print books, and created and presented Summer Reading Programs for our children. With grant assistance, local performing art groups some of which are Schuylkill Free Shakespeare, Gabriel Chamber Ensemble, Ashland Area Community Choir, Schuylkill Choral Society, Inc., and Lift Your Spirits Performing Arts, presented a wide range of musical and cultural events.

The Charles Werner Endowment Fund continues to support the children of the Pine Grove area, through support of the Pine Grove Community Church student ministry and library program, as well as offering free swim days through the Tremont Community Organization.

The graduating seniors of our county continue to receive scholarships and graduation awards due to the generosity and forethought of others. The students continue to accomplish amazing things and are bringing their education and experience back to Schuylkill County.

We thank you, our donors and friends, for supporting our Schuylkill County community through the Schuylkill Area Community Foundation.

## Why Establish a Fund?

The Schuylkill Area Community Foundation offers donors - individuals, families, businesses and nonprofit organizations - the flexibility and expertise needed to help them determine which type of fund best matches their interests and will achieve their philanthropic goal.

Minimum amount required to establish a fund:

\$5,000 . . . . to establish an annual award for a high school graduate

\$5,000 . . . . to establish any other fund \$20,000 . . . to establish a scholarship fund

## **Categories of Giving**

There are many ways to give through the Community Foundation. Here are some of the most common methods that donors choose:

## Cash

Cash is the easiest way to contribute. Donors who make gifts of cash are eligible for a charitable deduction in the year the gift was made.

## **Appreciated Stock**

Stocks may be donated to the Community Foundation as a charitable gift. Donors are eligible for a tax deduction for the fair market value of the stock and can avoid a capital gains tax.

## **Bequests**

A charitable bequest is the most common form of planned giving and it provides important estate tax advantages. Donors will continue their charitable legacies for years to come by including a gift in their will to support the causes or organizations that are important to them. SACF has recommended legal language for all types of charitable bequests.

## **Retirement Plans and Life Insurance**

Donors can use assets held in an individual retirement account (IRA), 401(k), 403(b), or a similar account to start a fund at the Community Foundation at the time of their death. These accounts, while very attractive to defer tax during lifetime, are the most heavily taxed assets in an estate at death.

## Charitable IRA Opportunity

Donors who are age 70-1/2 and older are able to make donations to charity from their IRA without needing to claim that distribution as income. To transfer a gift from your IRA, please contact your IRA administrator directly. Transfers from IRAs can be made to designated funds, field of interest funds, scholarship funds, and agency endowments. This provision does NOT allow transfers to Donor Advised Funds.

The Foundation has partnered with PayPal to provide a secure and convenient way to make your donation online. On the PayPal payment form, you can add special instructions such as designation to a specific fund, in memory/honor of (name) and privacy preference if you want to remain anonymous.

If you are considering a contribution greater than \$500, it is our recommendation that you submit payment by check using the printable donation form or contact the Foundation directly at (570) 624-7223.

Disclosure for making a donation through PayPal: The merchant fees are discounted for registered charities with 501(c)(3) status. The fee is 2.2% + 0.30 per transaction for donations up to 100,000.


