CHARITABLE GIFTING

There are many ways to give through the Community Foundation. Here are some of the most common methods that donors choose:

Cash

Cash is the easiest way to contribute. Donors who make gifts of cash are eligible for a charitable deduction in the year the gift was made.

Appreciated Stock

Stocks may be donated to the Community Foundation as a charitable gift. Donors are eligible for a tax deduction for the fair market value of the stock and can avoid a capital gains tax.

Bequests

A charitable bequest is the most common form of planned giving and it provides important estate tax advantages. Donors will continue their charitable legacies for years to come by including a gift in their will to support the causes or organizations that are important to them. SACF has recommended legal language for all types of charitable bequests.

Retirement Plans and Life Insurance

Donors can use assets held in an individual retirement account (IRA), 401(k), 403(b), or a similar account to start a fund at the Community Foundation at the time of their death. These accounts, while very attractive to defer tax during lifetime, are the most heavily taxed assets in an estate at death.

Charitable IRA Opportunity

Donors age 70-1/2 and older are able to make donations to charity from their IRA without needing to claim that distribution as income. To transfer a gift from your IRA, please contact your IRA administrator directly. Transfers from IRAs can be made to designated funds, field of interest funds, scholarship funds, and agency endowments. This provision does NOT allow transfers to Donor Advised Funds.

ESTABLISHING FUNDS

The Schuylkill Area Community Foundation offers donors - individuals, families, businesses and nonprofit organizations - the flexibility and expertise needed to help them determine which type of fund best matches their interests and will achieve their philanthropic goal.

Minimum amount required to establish a fund:

\$5,000 - to establish an annual award for a high school graduate

\$5,000 - to establish any other fund

\$20,000 - to establish a scholarship fund

This fund provides one annual scholarship to a member of the graduating class of Minersville Area High School, or its successor high school, pursuing post-secondary education in the field of auto mechanics.

John and Ann Snyder Outdoor Fund





This fund has been established in honor of John and Ann Snyder. John and Ann enjoyed the outdoors and were avid tent campers (along with their four children) in rustic campgrounds, primarily Poe Paddy State Park in Woodward, PA. They both fished for trout in the famous Penn's Creek that runs through the park. Many family hikes were taken on the dirt roads and trails surrounding the campground, including crossing an abandoned railroad trestle and through the 250 foot long Paddy Mountain Railroad Tunnel. John passed away suddenly in 2003 at the age of seventy-four. Ann battled various cancers for many years but took every opportunity to continue tent camping on her own through May of 2022 at the age of eighty-four.

John had camped and fished at Poe Paddy since he was a young boy and to honor that distinction, the State named a trail that runs along the creek the "John L. Snyder Trail," and recently officially renamed it the "John L. and Ann F. Snyder Trail."


Son John presented the idea of establishing a fund to his siblings to promote the love of the outdoors. With the help of the Foundation (which Ann had volunteered at for many years) a fund was set up. COVID restrictions were in place and Zoom meetings were taking place. Ann was very surprised when two of her children (Sue and Mark) appeared on the screen in front of her as part of the business meeting. Her daughter Ann was visiting her and was able to capture her surprise on camera and John was unfortunately detained at work, but arrived soon after the announcement.

The fund is available to qualifying organizations which conduct or will conduct programs or activities in the Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, community promoting education concerning and/or the enjoyment of nature and the outdoors. The Foundation shall determine what organizations, programs and activities qualify to receive grants through its annual grantmaking process.

Russell A. Frantz Memorial Award

Russell A. Frantz was a humble and kind man who truly wanted to help others and show his love and concern for everyone he knew. This award has been established in his memory to be

awarded to a student who leads by example, who doesn't seek out adoration, and who has the fortitude to do what's right.



Ken Smulligan Memorial Tamaqua Train Station Endowment Fund Annual distribution made to TACP for use in the restoration, improvement, repair and maintenance of the Tamaqua Train Station located at 18 N. Railroad St. Tamaqua, PA. The late Ken Smulligan was the founder of Tamaqua Save Our Station and the all-volunteer effort to save the 1874 Tamaqua Railroad Station from the brink of demolition. The station is now the centerpiece of Tamaqua's downtown, historic district, and community life because of his leadership.

The Tamaqua SOS Save Our Station purchased and installed a banner and also established a permanent, perpetual endowment fund in Ken's name, with the proceeds of the fund forever benefit the Tamaqua Train Station's preservation.

In 2023, the US Postal Services recognized the Tamaqua Railroad Station with one of only five Historic Railroad Station stamps recognizing significant historic railroad stations across the country. The Tamaqua Station was selected for the station's importance to the Tamaqua community and as an acknowledgment of the decades-long effort to save, restore, and preserve Tamaqua's #1 Landmark. There would be no stamp and no station if not for the effort and leadership of dedicated volunteer Ken Smulligan who dedicated himself to the saving of the historic 1874 Tamaqua Station that is now a vibrant restaurant, visitors center, and centerpiece of a greater revitalization effort.





Darlis E. Berger Memorial Fund

The Darlis E. Berger Memorial Fund was established in benevolent memory of a loving, devoted wife, mother, and grandmother. Throughout her life, Darlis tried to help others through various endeavors, but always in a quiet, non-assuming manner. She was an advocate for education, reading, and helping those in need. This memorial fund will support her three favorite charities with yearly distributions: Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, The Salvation Army, and the Ashland Public Library.





Meredith J. Barnhart was a 2001 graduate of Minersville Area High School and a 2005 Elizabethtown College graduate with a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work.

During her high school years, she played on Minersville's basketball and volleyball teams, was a member of the marching band, participated in the annual plays - both on stage and off with scenery set up, and was a member of the National Honor Society.

At Elizabethtown, she participated in the campus theater plays and became a member of the National Freshman Alpha Lambda Delta, Phi Alpha (Social Work), and Pi Mu Epsilon (Math), Honor Societies.

As a freshman entering Elizabethtown, she had chosen math as her major, but soon developed an interest in Social Work. After earning her Bachelor's degree, she went on to Columbia University to continue her education and earn a Master's Degree in Social Work. Equipped with both a Bachelor and Master degrees, she searched out employment and was accepted at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center in New York City in the pediatric oncology department. While there, Meredith worked tirelessly helping the children and their families obtain the treatments and services needed to combat their cancer diagnosis.

After ten years of working with the pediatric oncology patients and their families, she accepted another challenge and became part of the Leukemia Lymphoma Society. Her position as director of the IRC (Information Resource Center) allowed her to work with many cancer patients offering up to-date disease, treatment, and support information.

During her tenure at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, Meredith applied to the doctoral program at Fordham University in New York. She was accepted and began working on her doctoral thesis. She successfully defended her dissertation in April of 2020 and graduated with her PhD in Social Work that spring.

The many hours of research, the presentations made at social work conferences, and the hours of interviews she conducted all helped her develop a doctoral thesis that has made a positive impact on cancer patients and their families.

Meredith was a kind, compassionate, and dedicated person. Her concern for helping others was an important part of her life. Her dedication to her work was a very important aspect of her life but her loyalty, love, and concern for her fiancee, family and friends were also priorities in her life. Her love of music, Broadway shows, football, the Christmas season, especially Christmas trees, and the beach were often shared and loved by her fiancee, family and friends as well.

Her passing not only left a void for the Leukemia Lymphoma Society and the many clients she helped each day, but for her fiancee, family and friends as well.

Rotary Club of Hegins-Valley View Scholarship Fund

This fund provides a scholarship to a member of the graduating class of Tri-Valley High School, or its successor high school, who plans to further his or

her education in automotive, construction, cosmetology, or industrial trades. Service area trades including health, marketing, and child care are specifically excluded.

Ashland Area Midget Football Association,

Distributions are made to the Ashland Area Midget Football Association, Inc.

Ashland Downtown, Inc. Fund

Distributions are used for the upkeep. maintenance, and beautification of the Hoffman Boulevard Islands and the Hoffman Memorial in Ashland, PA.

Ashland Girl Scout Campership Fund

Distributions are used to pay for the attendance of Ashland area Brownies, Junior Girl Scouts, Cadet Girl Scouts, and Senior Girl Scouts at camp.

Ashland Public Library Fund

Distributions are made to the Ashland Public Library for the use by the library in defraying the expenses of its activities.

Ashland Tri-Centennial Fund

Distributions are made to the Ashland Borough Council for the benefit of the citizens of Ashland and for the general purposes of the borough.

Ashland Volunteer Fire Department, Washington Fire Company No. 1 and American Fire Company No. 1 Trust

Distributions are made to the fire companies to assist them in obtaining and maintaining their fire fighting equipment.

Beatrice Wasley Legacy Fund

Distributions are made to the Sisters of St. Casimir located in Chicago, Illinois to be used for personal care needs of the Sisters who are retired.

Ben Franklin Trust

Distributions are used to benefit the public libraries of Schuylkill and neighboring counties.

Bethany Children's Home Fund

Distributions are made to Bethany Children's Home for such uses and purposes as the Bethany Children's Home shall determine.

Butch Kennedy Memorial Fund

Distributions are made to the Anthracite Region Center for Independent Living - Disability Action Crew to provide direct financial assistance to individuals with an open case.

Carl F. Reichwein, M.D., Memorial Fund

Distributions are made to St. Mauritius and St. Joseph's Roman Catholic Churches or the consolidated church (which is currently St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church), Ashland to provide financial aid for children of the two parishes in obtaining education in Catholic elementary schools.

Chamber of Commerce Christmas **Decoration Fund**

Distributions are made to the Ashland Chamber of Commerce for its use in providing the annual Ashland Christmas decorations.

Distributions are made to St. Joseph's Catholic Church and St. Mauritius Catholic Church, Ashland or its successor (which is currently St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church), Ashland Public Library, Washington Fire Company Community Ambulance, and to projects as selected by the Directors.

Darlis E. Berger Memorial Fund

Distributions will benefit the Evangelical Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd, the Salvation Army Ashland service unit, and the Ashland Public Library.

David W. McClafferty Memorial Fund

Distributions are made to Hillside Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals for such uses and purposes as the organization shall determine.

Davis / Boehmer Family Fund


